It must be foreshadowed that learning conditions at the start of Term 2 are likely to be remote. Following the announcement by Premier Steven Marshall today that school holidays have been extended, I write to outline how St Dominic's Priory College will undertake our learning over the coming months. Reception – Year 11 Students: Face to face lessons conclude for Term 1 at 3:10pm (Primary) and 3:25pm (Secondary).
- **Friday 3 April 2020**  
Reception- Year 11 Students: *Remote Learning 4 St Dom's Girls* Check In Morning (details provided next week). Students are offsite.  
Year 12 Students: Lessons will run from 8:40am until 10:40am at the College.  
All Students: School Holidays Commence from 12:00 noon.
- **Week 11 (Monday 6 until Thursday 9 April 2020)**  
Staff Professional Learning and Preparation for *Remote Learning 4 St Dom's Girls*.  
Students on School Holidays. No formal lessons. If the extended holiday is causing difficulty for parents, please contact either Cate O'Leary or Muriel Noujaim.
- **Monday 27 April 2020**  
Staff Professional Development Day and Pupil Free Day for all Students.
