Dear Parents/Caregivers of Galilee students,

I am writing to provide an update on Cardijn College Galilee's response to the latest restrictions announced by the SA Government as a result of the positive COVID cases in Adelaide in recent days. At this stage, schools will continue to remain open and Term 2 will conclude at the end of this week as planned with a 3.10pm dismissal on Friday 2 July. All school activities scheduled to occur this week will continue as planned.

I want to reassure you that the College remains committed to providing a safe environment for our students and their families. We continue to reinforce with students the importance of good hygiene practices, cleaning hands thoroughly with soap and water, using hand sanitiser and adhering to social distancing as best as possible.

It is imperative that students stay home from school if they do not feel well and are showing any symptoms such as fever, cough, runny nose, high temperature, sore throat, loss of taste, headache and other serious symptoms such as shortness of breath or chest pain.
