

- 1. Quality, variety and accuracy of language used.
- 2. Language used meets a High Curriculum Achievement level for the appropriate grade.
- 3. Aesthetics- is writing reflected thoughtfully and attractively by the illustration / decoration/ design?
- 4. **X- factor**: does the entry spark interest, hold the viewer's attention, demonstrate an ability to use foreign language and communicate ideas on an interesting, original and imaginative way?
- 5. Does the entry meet the criteria and format for the category (Handwritten or Multimedia)?
