

Orthopaedic Surgery

- Arthrodesis
- **Arthroscopy: stifle, elbow, shoulder *MIS**
- Bone grafting
- Corrective osteotomy
- **Cruciate disease management: TPLO, CBLO, extracapsular repair**
- **Fracture repair (including MIPO) *E *MIS**
- Hip dysplasia: Hip denervation, FHNE, double pelvic osteotomy
- Hip luxation / dislocation *E
- **Medial patella luxation (MPL)**
- Open fractures *E

Flexible Endoscopy *NIP

- Balloon dilation: oesophagus, colon
- Biopsy: upper GI, nasal, urethra, bladder, vagina
- BAL: trachea, bronchii
- **Foreign body retrieval: upper GI, trachea *E**
- Polypectomy: rectum

Ultrasound *NIP

- **Abdominal**
- Guided biopsy / FNA (cytology)
- Joints – stifle, shoulder
- Muscle, tendon
- Guided drainage of cavity
- Superficial

Fluoroscopy

- Corrective osteotomy
- CSF tap
- **Minimally invasive fracture stabilisation *MIS**
- Myelography

Soft Tissue Surgery

- Arytenoid lateralisation
- Axial pattern flap
- Bladder stone removal
- **Brachycephalic airway obstructive syndrome**
- Diaphragmatic hernia *E
- Exploratory laparotomy
- Gastric dilatation and volvulus (GDV) *E
- Haem abdomen *E
- Intestinal foreign body removal *E
- Intussusception *E
- Laparoscopic assisted bladder stone removal *MIS
- **Laparoscopic desexing (spey) *MIS**
- **Laparoscopic gastropexy: GDV prevention *MIS**
- Laparoscopic liver biopsy *MIS
- Laparoscopic splenectomy *MIS
- Lung lobe torsion *E
- Negative pressure wound therapy
- Perineal hernia
- Portosystemic shunts
- Perineal urethrostomy
- Sialocoele
- Skin grafting
- Skin mass resection, wound reconstruction
- Splenectomy
- Total ear canal ablation
- **Wound management / debridement:** traumatic wounds, contaminated wounds, infected wounds, wound breakdown and wide margin resection *E
