

COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Promoter

- 1.1. This competition is conducted by IP Partnership Lawyers Pty Ltd ACN 635 049 811 of 64 Marine Parade, Southport QLD 4215 (**Promoter**).

2. Acceptance of Terms

- 2.1. By entering this competition, each entrant is deemed to have accepted these terms and conditions.

3. Competition Details

- 3.1. On 26 April 2026, the Promoter will publish a post on its social media accounts Instagram, LinkedIn and Facebook (**Post**) which will be reposted from time to time throughout the Promotional Period by the Promoter (**Reposts**).
- 3.2. The Post will feature a ball being kicked a certain distance (**Nominated Kick**).
- 3.3. The instructions for entry will be published together with the Post and Reposts.

(Competition)

4. Eligibility

- 4.1. Entry is open only to individuals who:
- (a) are residents of Australia;
 - (b) are aged 18 years or older, or if under 18 years of age, have obtained the consent of their parent or legal guardian to enter this competition and be bound by these terms and conditions;
 - (c) are not employees of the Promoter, its related bodies corporate, or any agencies associated with the Promoter or this competition; and
 - (d) are not the spouse, de facto spouse, parent, child or sibling, whether by birth or adoption, of any such employee.

(Eligible Entrant)

- 4.2. The Promoter may require the Eligible Entrant to provide proof of their age, identity and residence.

5. Promotional Period

- 5.1. The competition opens at 9am AEST on 26 April 2026 and closes at 9am AEST on 11 June 2026 (**Promotional Period**).
- 5.2. Entries received outside the Promotional Period will not be accepted.

6. How to Enter

- 6.1. To enter, the Eligible Entrant must during the Promotional Period:

- (a) guess the distance (in metres) of the Nominated Kick in the Post and Reposts (**Guess**);
- (b) use the link provided by the Promoter on the Post and Reposts to go to the online form on the Promoter's website (**Online Form**); and
- (c) submit the Guess via the Online Form (**Entry**).

6.2. The Eligible Entrant will be required to provide the contact details requested by the Promoter on the Online Form.

6.3. Only one Entry per Eligible Entrant will be permitted unless the Promoter states otherwise.

6.4. Incomplete, indecipherable, illegible or non-compliant entries will be invalid.

7. Entry Conditions

7.1. Each Eligible Entrant warrants that their Entry complies with these terms and conditions.

7.2. The Promoter reserves the right to:

- (a) verify the validity of entries and Eligible Entrants, including identity, age and place of residence, and
- (b) disqualify any Eligible Entrant whose entry is not in accordance with these terms and conditions or who tampers with the entry process.
- (c) By entering the Competition, the winner consents to their name and town or suburb of residence being published on the Promoter's website, social media accounts or other promotional material.

8. Determination of Winner

8.1. The winner of the Competition will be the Eligible Entrant whose Guess is closest to the distance of the Nominated Nick.

8.2. The distance of the Nominated Kick will be determined by the Promoter in its reasonable discretion using the measurement method specified in the Post or, if not specified there, by the Promoter's appointed officials using such measurement tools, video review, on-ground assessment, or other reasonable method as the Promoter considers appropriate.

8.3. For the purposes of this Competition, the distance of the Nominated Kick is final once determined by the Promoter.

8.4. No random draw will be conducted in this Competition.

9. Tie-Break

9.1. If two or more Eligible Entrants submit the same Guess, the winner will be the tied Eligible Entrant whose Entry was first received by the Promoter.

10. Winner Notification

10.1. The winner will be notified by email, phone, and/or announcement on the Promoter's social media accounts within three (3) business days after the winner is determined.

10.2. The Promoter may publish the winner's name and town or suburb of residence on its website, social media accounts or other promotional material.

11. Claiming the Prize

- 11.1. The winner must, within seven (7) days after being notified (**Claim Period**), provide all information reasonably required by the Promoter to claim the prize, including delivery and booking details if applicable.
- 11.2. If the winner does not claim the prize or provide the required details within the Claim Period, or is found to be ineligible, the Promoter may award the prize to the Eligible Entrant with the next closest valid Guess.

12. Prize

- 12.1. The prize includes:

- (a) two (2) tickets to State of Origin Game 3 on Wednesday 8 July 2026 at 8:05pm at Suncorp Stadium in Brisbane QLD; and

(Prize)

- 12.2. The Prize:

- 12.3. Use of any tickets forming part of the Prize is subject to the terms and conditions of the ticket issuer, venue and event organiser.

13. Prize Substitution and Event Changes

- 13.1. If any part of the Prize becomes unavailable for reasons beyond the Promoter's reasonable control, including if the relevant event is postponed, rescheduled, cancelled, relocated or conducted without spectators, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute that part of the Prize with a prize of equal or greater value, subject to any applicable law.

14. Social Media Disclaimer

- 14.1. If the Competition is promoted through Facebook, Instagram or any other social media platform, the Competition is in no way sponsored, endorsed, administered by, or associated with that platform.
- 14.2. Each Eligible Entrant releases the relevant social media platform from any and all liability arising out of or in connection with the Competition.

15. Entry Content

- 15.1. If the Competition requires the Eligible Entrants to submit comments, text, images or other materials as part of their entry, each Eligible Entrant warrants that such content:
- (a) is their own original work or that they otherwise have the right to submit it;

- (b) does not infringe the rights of any person;
- (c) is not defamatory, offensive, unlawful or inappropriate; and
- (d) complies with the terms and conditions of such social media platform as they are published.

15.2. By entering, each Eligible Entrant grants the Promoter a non-exclusive, royalty-free, worldwide licence to use, reproduce and publish the Entry content for the purpose of administering and promoting the Competition and the Promoter's business.

16. Disqualification and Cancellation

16.1. The Promoter may disqualify any Eligible Entrant who:

- (a) submits an Entry that is incomplete, indecipherable, illegible or non-compliant;
- (b) tampers with the entry process;
- (c) engages in misleading, deceptive, fraudulent or unlawful conduct in connection with the Competition; or
- (d) breaches these terms and conditions.

16.2. If for any reason the Competition is not capable of running as planned, including because of technical failure, unauthorised intervention, fraud, virus, bug, tampering or any cause beyond the Promoter's reasonable control, the Promoter may, to the extent permitted by law, cancel, suspend, modify or terminate the Competition.

17. Liability

17.1. Nothing in these terms and conditions excludes, restricts or modifies any consumer guarantee, right or remedy conferred by the Australian Consumer Law contained in Schedule 2 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth) (**ACL**) or any other applicable law that cannot lawfully be excluded, restricted or modified.

17.2. Subject to the above, the Promoter is not responsible for any late, lost, incomplete, misdirected or incorrectly submitted entries, or for any technical malfunction, delay or failure affecting the Competition or the receipt of entries.

17.3. Subject to any rights that cannot be excluded by law, the Promoter is not liable for any loss, damage or injury suffered or sustained in connection with the Competition or any prize.

18. Privacy

18.1. The Promoter may collect, use and disclose the personal information of the Eligible Entrants for the purposes of administering the Competition, contacting the Eligible Entrants, publishing winner information.

18.2. the Eligible Entrants should direct any request to access, update or correct personal information to the Promoter.

19. Governing Law

19.1. These terms and conditions are governed by the laws of Queensland, Australia.

- 19.2. The Eligible Entrants submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Queensland and courts competent to hear appeals from those courts.
