What is Apprentice Employment?

ATEC employs you and then arranges placements with another employer (a Host Employer) for an agreed period of time. We are responsible for apprentice wages, entitlements and training for the term of your apprenticeship, while the Host Employer provides employment and on-job training.

What are the benefits of being employed by ATEC?

ATEC Apprentice Employment manages your apprenticeship to ensure continuous employment with one or more Host Employers and monitors the quality of your training to better develop your skills. We ensure you are:

- Paid the correct wages, allowances and entitlements
- Placed in a safe work environment
- Well supervised and trained
- Fairly treated

Wages

ATEC employs you and then arranges placements with another employer (a Host Employer) for an agreed period of time. We are responsible for apprentice wages, entitlements and training for the term of your apprenticeship, while the Host Employer provides employment and on-job training.

Training

An Apprentice is required to successfully complete 24 modules / units of study over the first three years of an apprenticeship. The training is coordinated by a Registered Training Organisation (such as ATEC or TAFE) and involves classroom-based, off-job training and workplace-based assessment. Your training program will be negotiated between you, ATEC Apprentice Employment and your Host Employer within the first month of your apprenticeship.
