### SENIOR SATURDAY TEAM ENTRY INSTRUCTION SHEET

#### 1. ENTRIES CLOSE FRIDAY 23 AUGUST 2024.

2. Entries will only be accepted by email using the Senior Saturday editable PDF Entry form.
3. Entries to be attached to emails sent to the Team Entry Registrar, David Kimberley [senior.records@waverleytennis.asn.au](mailto:senior.records@waverleytennis.asn.au)
4. Entry fee per team – \$55 (with a 10% discount for paying on time)
5. Entry fees will be invoiced to clubs around the third round.
6. A saved copy of all Entry Forms should be retained by the club.
7. Teams using outside venues must include the information on the entry forms. If nominating a team to always use an outside include the name of the first player listed in the team.
8. Grading of each player is to be based on Association grading (A, A Res, B Sp etc.) EACH PLAYER MUST HAVE THEIR GRADING LISTED ON THE ENTRY FORM. Current player gradings are shown in ClubZone.
9. A player's grading is retained from season to season unless a change is approved by the WDTA.
  - if changing a player's personal grading this should be highlighted and an explanation given in the comments area of the entry form.
10. Team members in Open Singles/Doubles sections must be listed in order of merit on entry forms.
11. Singles/Doubles teams are graded based on the highest graded player.
12. **Entry forms must show the previous season details requested on entry form** including both grade and section and, if not WDTA, Association name. Pennant grades must be shown wherever possible. (Previous season info etc., available from Clubzone Club Player Statistics).  
***Please note that we require previous competition experience.***  
***For new teams or new players to Waverley Tennis Senior competition, providing the UTR for the new player or players will assist in team placement.***
13. Apply for either a high, middle, or low section within a grade. If more than one team in a grade then teams must be ranked in order of merit and entered as "low 1, low 2, etc.".
14. Additional comments to assist grading may be added.
15. Grade applied for must be consistent with personal grading of team members.
16. All nominated players in teams are expected to play on a regular basis and any teams who use almost exclusively emergency players instead may not be accepted in future seasons.
