Waverley Tennis expects parents to observe the following "CODE OF CONDUCT"

Remember that children play sport for their enjoyment, not yours.

Support participation by your children - let it be their decision to compete.

Focus on the child's efforts and self-esteem rather than whether they win or lose.

Never belittle or shout at a child for making a mistake, or for the team losing a match.

Remember that children learn best by example - applaud the efforts of players on both sides of the net.

Always encourage children to play tennis according to the rules.

Show appreciation of Venue Supervisors and other volunteers, without whom your child could not play tennis.

Help ensure that verbal and physical abuse do not occur at the tennis club.

Respect Venue Supervisors' decisions and teach children to do the same.

Remember that smoking and the consumption of alcohol is unacceptable at Junior tennis.
