Q: "We were half way through our matches and were washed-out. We were ahead, so have we won? ie: Do we receive the 2 additional points?"

A: With an unfinished game to have an outright winner, they must be far enough ahead that it is impossible for the opposition team to be able to win, even if the opposition team won every game from then on.

Q: "With our unfinished match, I entered the results on-line, but it registers as 'a draw'. Is this correct?"

A: Even though it says "a Draw", the points will not necessarily be 4 - 4. You still are awarded all sets that you have won, however the unfinished sets points will be shared as well as the final 2 points.

Q: "Can any player call a heatout, or just the Captains?"

A: If the temperature has reached 30 C, ANY player feeling "heat affected" may choose to stop play and the Captain then calls a heatout. Alternatively, if it reaches 30 C, but no players are feeling heat affected and feel fine to continue on without stopping, play should not be halted.

Q: "Can we change the order of players to what is written on the scoresheet?"

A: Once the score sheet has been written out the team must play in that order.
