- 5. Each entry must be accompanied by an official entry form, original or photocopied. Please note that the entrant's name must not appear on the work itself.
- 6. Each entry in the Section A non-fiction prose and all short story sections should be accompanied by a word count to **appear on both** the work itself and the entry form.
- 7. Each entry must be typed on A4 size paper. Please ensure that each entry is carefully proofread before it is forwarded for judging.
