



## BURSARIES - GENERAL INFORMATION

A Bursary recognises various talents of a student and his capacity to benefit from the nurturing of these gifts in Rostrevor's educational environment. Being a member of the Rostrevor environment offers the student an opportunity to develop and to contribute to the life of the College in the belief that students gain much for themselves in the experience of sharing their abilities with and for others.

The College offers the following bursaries:

- General Bursaries - negotiated with the Principal or the Business Manager
- School Card – Government means tested scheme for low income families. Eligible families may be offered 40% remission of tuition fees.

Families requesting financial assistance are asked to complete an Application for Fee Remission. This provides the College with information to ensure that assistance is provided to families most in need. A meeting with the Business Manager would usually be arranged for the same day as the enrolment interview.

Once a student has commenced at Rostrevor College, Bursaries are subject to an annual review of financial circumstances. If remission is sought for the following year, families are asked to complete a new Application for Fee Remission. A Bursary may also recognise the financial difficulties of the family and the hardship it would place upon a student to move if they are currently benefiting from Rostrevor's environment.

Families are required to meet all other charges related to a student's education at the College. They include the balance of the Tuition Fees, stationery, uniforms (including uniforms for sport) and the additional costs if the recipient chooses to participate in interstate sporting trips and music tuition.

Students accepting Bursaries are required to meet the other enrolment criteria of the College with regard to philosophical and religious disposition. Bursaries are also subject to the quality of the family and the student's compliance and contribution, the student's educational performance and general participation in College life.
