#### 1st XI Cricket

Our opening bowlers of **Patrick Shrestha** and **Dylan Smith** bowled well with the new ball to have PAC 3/20 at one stage, however a 120 run partnership for the 3rd wicket and some big hitting towards the end of the innings allowed PAC to reach 201 from their allotted 45 overs. Our bowlers toiled manfully and it was pleasing to see **Cale Elefsen** in his debut 1st XI game bowl 7 economical overs.

In reply, the wickets fell regularly and aside from a partnership of 36 between **Harrison Rahaley** and **Dylan Fitzsimons**, we struggled to gain any momentum. **Scott Hammat**, also playing his first game, showed enough to suggest that he will be a solid contributor in the future.
