Resource Fee

Reception to Year 6	-	\$575.00
Years 7 to 9	-	\$725.00
Years 10 to 12	-	\$800.00

The Resource fee covers such items as:

- Learning Area charges
- Care Education Program
- Selected targeted resources - i.e. Digital Subscriptions
- IT Levies to cover on-line connections, software and maintenance
- Textbooks hire, replacements and upgrades
- Facilities Management

Resource Fees will be invoiced in January 2021 and are payable by the end of February 2021.

Donations to the School Building Fund

The College requests each family make a \$250.00 voluntary School Building Fund donation each year. **This donation is tax deductible.** The School Building Fund appears on your monthly statements for ease of payment. These donations make a tangible difference to the College's ability to maintain and improve the high-quality facilities the students enjoy. Families may spread the School Building Fund donation across the year via the direct debit system. When paying by direct debit the Finance Department will provide you with a tax receipt in June and December.

Discounts

Family Discount

For families with multiple students studying at St Mary's College, refer to the Tuition Fee Table.

Prompt Discount

St Mary's College offers a 5% discount on the Tuition Fee component only for families who have no outstanding fees from the previous year and who pay their Tuition Fee in full by 28 February 2021. Prompt payment discount does not apply to the Resource Fee.

Sibling Discount

St Mary's College offers a 5% discount to the Tuition fee only for families with siblings at another Catholic School. Families can apply for the discount via a Sibling Discount Form.

Payment Options

The College requests each family complete a formal Payment Plan to address their 2021 College Fees, choosing either Payment Option A or Payment Option B, as detailed below. This ensures the punctual payment of fees enabling the College to provide the highest level of service and facilities to families. Completed Payment Plan Forms are to be returned to the College by 29 January 2021.

Payment Option A:

Pay in full by 28 February 2021 to receive 5% discount on Tuition Fee component of your Invoice.

Payment Option B:

Via a Direct Debit from a Bank account or Credit Card (Visa and Mastercard only)

Families with Financial Difficulties (School Card)

School Card Forms are available from the following government website <http://www.sa.gov.au> or from the College Front Office. Families intending to apply for School Card, are asked to indicate this on the payment plan. The College requests that completed application forms are submitted early in Term 1 2021. If qualified, a possible remission of up to 40% will apply to the Tuition component of fees. Families who do not qualify for School Card but may still require assistance due to their financial situation and/or for special circumstances, may apply for a Variation in Fees. Assessments on eligibility will be determined during an interview, supported by the appropriate financial documentation. Contact the Fees Officer to arrange an interview.

Other Fees and Charges

Book List

Each November the College distributes a Book List detailing required stationery items and subject specific books which are required to be purchased from Campions.

Student Laptops

St Mary's College is a Bring Your Own Device school. Families have the option to purchase devices independently or via the College recommended contractor detailed on the College website.

Vocational Education and Training (VET)

Where a student chooses to study a VET course as a replacement to one of their subject options in Year 10, 11 and 12, the course fee is subsidised 50:50 up to a maximum of \$350.00. This amount will be refunded on successful completion of the course, provided the student maintains their studies and attendance at both St Mary's College and the course.

The cost of extra VET courses in addition to a full St Mary's College study load will be the financial responsibility of the family.

Subjects Studied Off Campus

On occasion, a student may wish to study a subject that does not fit in their timetable or that is not available at St Mary's College. Where this subject is within a standard load, the course fee will be subsidised 50:50 up to a maximum of \$350.00.

This amount will be refunded on successful completion of the course, provided the student maintains their studies and attendance at both St Mary's College and the course.

The cost of extra courses in addition to the full SMC study load are the financial responsibility of the family.

Open Access College

Where a student's circumstances dictate consideration of enrolling in Open Access, the College will consider all options available. The objective will be to negotiate and achieve the most cost-efficient arrangement for both the family and the College.

Nomination Fee:	\$70.00 non-refundable unless team is not constituted, paid upfront.
Uniform:	\$30.00 Hire
Registration Fee:	For selected sports as notified by the Sports Department paid up front.
Coaching Fee:	Specialist programs (eg Volleyball and Netball) incurs a \$110.00 Levy per sport – paid up front.
Representative Fee:	\$30.00.

The Child Care Rebate is available to all families through Centrelink. Families must register and be assessed with Centrelink before qualifying for the Child Care Rebate/Benefit.

Special Arrangements

Parents and Guardians are advised that one term's notice must be received in writing to the Principal when intending to withdraw their daughter from the College. If no notice is provided on a student leaving St Mary's College, one term's fees will be payable in lieu of notice.

Payment of school fees is still required where a student is absent from school for any length of time, eg. an overseas holiday.

The College expects all families to be up to date with their tuition fees when nominating their daughter for any interstate/overseas College trips.

The St Mary's College Board acknowledges its responsibility to take all reasonable and legal steps, including a debt collection agency, where necessary, to ensure College Fees are collected in full.

Families experiencing difficulties with the payment of their school fees, or requiring further assistance, are encouraged to contact the Business Manager or the Accounts Department to discuss their arrangements.

School Care Insurance

All students receive cover via the Catholic Church Insurance School Care insurance. School Care is a student accident insurance policy specifically designed for schools. The policy provides benefits for a range of non-Medicare medical services, such as dental and physiotherapy costs, which are incurred because of an accident during a school activity. Additional expenses such as medical expenses (allowable by law), emergency transport, home tuition and school fee relief are also payable under the policy.
