Dear Parents and Guardians

Thank you for your ongoing support and engagement with the College during the **Remote Learning 4 St Dom's girls** to begin Term 2. Our teachers and students have worked hard to develop new skills as we have managed our learning using SEQTA, Seesaw and other digital platforms. I congratulate our staff and our students for their commitment to their work and studies.

I am pleased to inform parents and students that from next week (Week 2) all students from Reception to Year 12 will return to on site learning, following our normal timetable. The **Remote Learning 4 St Dom's Girls** program will not be implemented unless the government advises us differently.

To ensure that we remain a COVID-19 safe school, I ask families to follow the guidelines as presented by Chief Public Health Officer, Professor Nicola Spurrer. Specifically, please be reminded:

- Do not send your daughter to school if she is sick. Please notify the College in the usual way.
- We ask that parents do not enter the school grounds unless reporting to the College Reception.
- We have plenty of hand sanitiser and soap. Students and staff will be advised to continue to wash their hands regularly.
- The College has continued with the increase of cleaning of classrooms, hand rails, lockers etc.
- We will not hold large gatherings of students unless advised otherwise by the Government.
- We will model and encourage physical distancing, recognising that this is not always easy to enforce in a school setting.

We are looking forward to seeing all of the girls next week as we return to teaching and learning in the classroom.
