Dear Families,

I write to you following this afternoon's announcement by Premier, Steven Marshall directing that South Australia will go into a minimum six-day lockdown, beginning from midnight tonight. This announcement will have an immediate impact on all South Australians. The following communication aims to outline the implications for students and families at St Dominic's Priory College.

The College will be closed tomorrow, Thursday 19 November and Friday 20 November and there will be no formal learning on these two days. A skeleton staff will be on site to offer supervision for children whose parents are deemed 'essential services workers'. All other staff will remain at home. Supervision will take place in the College Library from 8:30 am until 3:30 pm. If your daughter requires on site supervision, please complete [this link](#).

From Monday 23 November until further notice, students from Little Dom's through to Year 9 will be learning at home. You will note that your daughter has brought home her laptop (Years 5-9) and other learning resources needed to complete her studies. Further to this, students will access their learning via SEQTA and SeeSaw as per the guidelines in our **Remote Learning 4 St Dom's Girls** documents.

Other than the clearance process of return of books and laptops (date to be advised), for Year 10 and 11 students, the 2020 school year will now conclude. Unfortunately, the remaining examinations will not be undertaken. The Semester 2 reports will reflect this.
