Dear Parishioners:

I am sure you were all surprised to be awakened by snow last Sunday (March 31st). Life is full of surprises! Like many of you, I am looking forward to more sunny days, following such a cold winter.

Last Sunday was also the first collection for Share Life, and I am pleased to report that \$40,000 was raised for the first of our three collections for Share Life. That is quite impressive and I thank you for your generosity to the Share Life campaign, which raises funds to support the many charities and agencies served by the Archdiocese, as well as its support to outreach ministries and the education of seminarians. This weekend, April 6th/7th, you will meet a very inspiring young man, a seminarian at St. Augustine's Seminary, in Scarborough. His name is James Cyfko, and he will offer a reflection on his spiritual journey as well as to thank you, for your commitment to Share Life. James may be familiar to you, since he was one of the four men and women who ran our summer camp this past year for the children of the parish; James worked hard to provide a wonderful experience for the young people in the camp that is known as "Totus Tuus". This camp will be held again this summer, and our Youth Director, Jessica Bews, will be signing up interested youth starting this weekend. More information on this camp is provided in another section of this bulletin; last year, close to 60 young people came out for an enjoyable experience.

This Sunday evening, I also invite you, if you are free, to the parish hall for our monthly Lectio Divina which will be streamed live from the Cathedral. Cardinal Collins will lead us in a reflection starting at 7:30 p.m. – 8:15 p.m. Once he completes his spiritual reflection, he will speak to us live by way of our live-feed camera in the parish hall. It should be a wonderful experience and I am sure many of you might wish to hear him and to thank him for his monthly spiritual reflections, as well as to ask questions related to his presentation.

During the past two Sundays of Lent, and continuing this Sunday, those studying to become Catholic at Easter have received special blessings at our 11:00 a.m. Mass. One of the special Rites of the RCIA program is the Rite of Scrutiny. If you think about the word "scrutiny", it essentially means to examine our way of life, especially our spiritual lives, and to pray that all sin and evil is removed. You may have noticed these men and women (and even young children) come forward to the front of the altar to be prayed over; the priest invites everyone present to pray for them and then offers a special prayer that they may be protected from all sin and evil in their lives. Lent provides us all an opportunity to repent, and to seek confession, so that the Lord's love and

grace may heal us, and our sins forgiven through the Sacrament of Reconciliation. I invite your continued prayers for these candidates who come before us to seek eventual entrance into the Catholic Church. As I often mention, the fact they want to join us is a testament to the power of your witness in their lives. However, in return they also witness to us, by encouraging us to be better and to truly place the Lord first in our hearts

Finally, please note the Holy Week and Easter schedule which is provided in this bulletin. Perhaps keep it on your fridge or in a place you can refer to it. I am sure you will want to participate in this most sacred week of our Christian lives.

In closing, let us continue to pray for one another. May God bless you in this time of Lent.
