



Jesus Goes Back to Heaven

Luke 24:44-53;
Acts 1:1-14

Jesus stayed on earth 40 days after He rose from the dead. He told His disciples, "Go to all the people in the whole world. Make them My disciples. Baptize them in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Teach them all about Me. And remember, I will always be with you."

Jesus also promised His disciples a special gift from heaven. He said, "Stay in Jerusalem and wait. Wait for My gift—the Holy Spirit."

Then, one day Jesus led His disciples out of Jerusalem. It was time for Jesus to go back to heaven. Jesus told the disciples, "The Holy Spirit will come to you. You will be filled with God's power. And you will tell people all over the world about Me."

Jesus lifted His hands and blessed the disciples. Then He began to rise from the earth. Higher and higher He went. The disciples watched Jesus rise in the sky. A cloud floated across the sky. It hid Jesus. Now the disciples could not see Him. But they still looked up at the sky.

Suddenly two angels stood beside the disciples. They were dressed in white. The angels said, "Why are you looking up at the sky? Jesus has gone to heaven. But He will come back in the same way you saw Him go." Then the disciples walked back to Jerusalem. They felt very happy. They knew He would return. And they believed that He would always be with them.
