

FORMATION AND ACCOMPANIMENT




• To establishing ongoing formation and accompaniment programs in our Districts and Regions that guide and mentor the next generation of Lasallians in providing educational services to the poor.

• To supporting co-responsibility through shared governance and animation in sustaining effective administration, achieving set goals, and delivering quality services across different areas of Lasallian life and mission.




LEADERSHIP AND ANIMATION
