MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: Changes Affecting Courtrooms 101, 104, 202, 206
Brampton Court House

Please be informed that effective December 12th and December 16th, 2016, the following changes will be implemented relevant to the utilization of the above mentioned courtrooms:

Effective Monday, December 12th, 2016, the pilot video project regarding bail readiness in courtroom 206 will cease. Please note, however, that the 2:15 pm video list will continue to be heard in this courtroom.

Effective Monday, December 12th, 2016, all adult bail matters will now begin in Courtroom 101, excluding lengthy bails, which will commence in their previously assigned courtroom.

Effective Friday, December 16th, 2016, the following matters will be heard in courtroom 202 on Fridays only, and at the times noted below:

- **9:00 am** – Pre-enquêtes only, limited to two (2) matters per week;
- **10:00 am** – All Section 810 Peace Bonds on consent by the parties; Careless Driving Resolutions where the parties have determined there should be a resolution under *the Highway Traffic Act*, Section 130; Private Informations. In addition, this court will function as an assist bail court when possible.

Please note that in cases where Defendants, who have been granted a Judicial Interim Release Order, and where the surety has yet to be approved and does not attend on the date to finalize the release, will no longer be remanded to courtroom 104 on the following day. The Defendant will be released from the institution via FAX. They should however be given a short remand in the event that no surety materializes.

I thank you in advance for your ongoing support and anticipated cooperation in implementing these necessary changes. Moving forward, we will continue to explore ways to enhance the use of video services and other modernization initiatives in order to ensure we continue to increase our efficiencies and provide the best possible services to the clients we serve.
