

**RECOMMENDED WORDING FOR AN ORDER FOR
LOCATE AND APPREHEND ORDERS UNDER THE CHILDREN'S LAW REFORM ACT**

1. **Locate and Apprehend Children.** Pursuant to section 36 of the *Children's Law Reform Act*, police forces in the Province of Ontario, including but not limited to the *Peel Regional Police*, are DIRECTED AND AUTHORIZED:
- (a) to do all things that may reasonably be done to locate and apprehend the **^child/ren**, namely:
 - (i) [full legal name], a **[boy/girl]** born **[date of birth]** and deliver **him/her/them** into the care of the **[party & full legal name]**; and
 - (b) to enter and search any place, AT ANY TIME OF DAY OR NIGHT, where he or she has reasonable or probable grounds to believe the **^child/ren** may be, with such assistance and such force as are reasonable in the circumstances;
 - (c) but this order to apprehend the **^child/ren** expires six (6) months from the date of this Order, unless specifically extended or terminated earlier by further court order.
