## Passive Screening

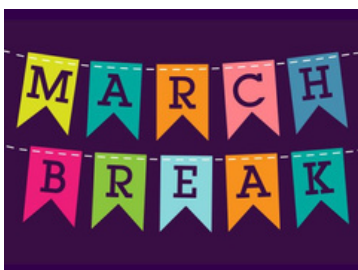
As of March 1, 2022 we have made some changes to our COVID protocols. There will be NO more active screening that is required by our members within your Uplifter account.

Now, you we will have a passive screening requirement. Simply put, if you and/or your child experiences any COVID symptoms, you live with someone isolating with a positive COVID test, you live with someone isolating because of COVID symptoms, you live with someone waiting for COVID test results or you have been identified as a close contact then you're **NOT** allowed to attend gymnastics or enter our facility.

Otherwise, if the above does not apply to you and/or your child you're allowed to participate in gymnastics or enter our facility.
