

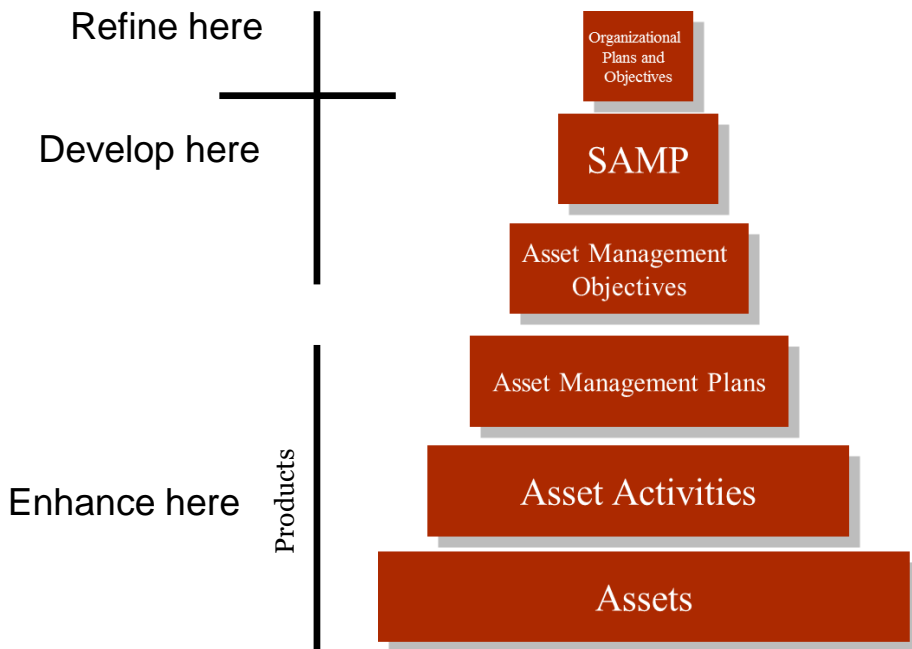

 - move to a leaner 'smart-buyer' model that better leverages industry, is more commercially oriented and achieves value for money
 - implements the most appropriate procurement model for delivering capability and achieving value for money



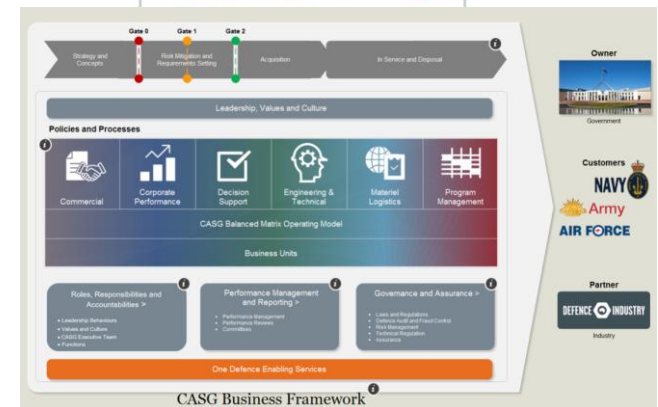
