

Certificate II in Automotive Underbody Technology AUR21216

COURSE DESCRIPTION & PATHWAYS:

This is a pre-apprenticeship courses designed to provide the foundation qualification reflected in the role of individuals who perform a limited range of tasks on the underbody systems of a variety of vehicles in the automotive retail, service and repair industry.

This course can lead to an apprenticeship and career as an Automotive Mechanic, Automotive Electrician, Heavy and/or Light Vehicle Mechanic. Diesel Fitting and Engine Reconditioning, Marine Mechanic, Small Engine Mechanic or Motorcycle Mechanic.
