


**REPORT FROM PRINCIPALS**

1. Name of Committee: Catholic Capital Grants (Victoria) LTD - CCG
2. Name of Person Submitting this Response: Mary Farah
3. Number of Meetings called over the Year: 6
4. Number of Meetings attended over the Year: 6
5. **Major Issues Discussed:**
  - On 10 July 2020, the Department advised Catholic Capital Grants (CCG VIC Ltd) on the initial allocations for 20221, 2022 and 2023.
  - On this basis there is now a notional funding pool of \$35 million available for allocation to projects under the 2021 schedule for both the Primary and Secondary Committees. This means that there is approximately \$16.9 million for Primary Places, \$14.6 million for Secondary Places and \$3.5 million for the joint committee.
  - A total of 140 applications were received under Round 2 of the Victorian Capital Funding program 2019 – 2023.
  - Indicative funding available – Under round 2 of the VGCFP, it is anticipated that CCG(Vic) ltd will have access to approximately \$70 million for distribution.

**Major Decisions Taken:**

- All eligible applications have undergone merit assessment and a short list was finalized by all members of the committee
- Limited school visits were undertaken this year due to the restrictions associated with COVID – 19.
- The list finalized was totaling \$105M, which is the amount available to Catholic schools under Round 2.
- The unsuccessful applications under the VGCFP 2019 – 23 that have also been assessed by the committee as high need will be further considered under the Australian Government Capital Grants Program.
