Dear Parents and Carers,

I would like to again take this opportunity to thank you for your ongoing support and cooperation during this time of challenge and change. It has been a very busy time everywhere and at Antonio we have been assessing learning progress, reflecting on our achievements and preparing for student reports to be sent home next week.

Nature Play Development Update

This week we have completed the next steps to bring our Nature Play Development closer to starting. The detailed drawings for each section of the development have been completed with the required adjustments to ensure we meet Australian Standards. We have also chosen a superintendent to oversee the tender process which requires a minimum of 21 days. At this stage we are planning for construction to begin in August and be completed by the end of the school year. The updated drawings are on display in the front office and include the drawings below.
